All parents of high schoolers are asked to work in the concession stand during the year. Even though your student may not participate in the sports listed below, profits from the concession stand support all extracurricular activities at WHS such as band, one-acts, speech, golf, cross-country, FBLA, cheerleading, etc.

The concession stand is the primary way Booster Club makes money. Last year, the concession stand made over \$11,000. At the end-of-year WHS Booster Club meeting, this money was then disbursed between the various Wausa High School student activities.

We are counting on each parent to participate, and most of you have been scheduled for more than one date. It would be impossible to know all of your schedules when making a concession stand schedule, so conflicts are bound to happen. If you are unable to work on your scheduled event, it is your responsibility to find a replacement or trade with another parent. If you and your spouse are scheduled to work, we are depending on both of you to be there.
